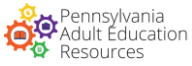
- Change to compulsory school age

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How Did We Get Here?



- Summer 2018 – Requirement to offer online SDL
- Summer 2019
 - Approximately 6% of enrolled learners did SDL.
 - Goal: Improve participation.
- March 2019 (pre-pandemic)
 - Approximately 10% participation.
 - 60% of agencies increased participation rate by 50%.
 - 35% of agencies increased participation rate by 100%.

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Today



- PA adult education programs:
- Offering webinar classes.
 - Offering online SDL.
 - Offering print SDL.
 - Conducting remote intake/orientation.
 - Proctoring Tests Remotely.

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Distance Learning Resources

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Remote Proctoring

- Remote proctoring guidelines developed by specific test publishers to ensure security.
 - Urgency to meet COVID-19-related need.
 - Inconsistencies in approaches by TABE/CASAS.
 - Relied on using current online versions of assessments.
- PA piloted protocols to ensure guidelines were clear and led to smooth testing process for students.
 - Best Plus – Literacy Pittsburgh.
 - CASAS – Community Learning Center, IU 5.
 - TABE – TIU 11, LLIU 13.

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Austin (Texas) Community College

- On pace to assess 500+ students by August 31.
- Process includes:
 - Host greets students, checks test readiness (audio, video and environment), then moves them to a private testing breakout room.
 - Proctor verifies student identity & administer test.
 - Has separate breakout room for tech support.
- Staffing:
 - One test administrator.
 - Four proctors.
 - One tech support.
- Will schedule seven students per hour.

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Approved SDL Resources



- Approved resources listed in Policy D.130.
- Requesting approval for new resources.
 - PA Adult Education Resource DL page.
 - Same form for online and print resources.
- Biggest issue:
 - Online resources with no time-on-task reports.

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Online ESL Resources



- Eleven resources currently approved.
- Most align to ELPS:
 - 1: Construct meaning from oral presentations and text ...
 - 8: Determine the meaning of words and phrases ...
 - 10: Demonstrate command of conventions of English ...
- Four resources approved for ABE/ASE:
 - Khan Academy
 - New Readers Press Online
 - Newsela Pro
 - Reading Horizons

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Online ESL Resources



- USA Learns (and Khan Academy) – Free.
- Cell-Ed
 - Developed for mobile phones. (Do not have to be smart.)
 - Time-on-task reports by vendor.
- Voxy
 - Contextualized for various workplaces/occupations.
 - Expensive
- DLP uses USA Learns, Khan Academy, and Burlington English.

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Online ABE/ASE Resources



- Seventeen Resources Currently Approved.
 - Note: Multiple resources by same publisher counted once.
- "Alignment" to CCRS.
 - Not all resources cover all subjects and levels.
- Read Theory.
 - Only online resource using teacher verification.

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Online ABE/ASE Resources



- Khan Academy – Free.
- Essential Education Products.
 - Talking characters in classroom setting.
- IXL – Excellent for student mastery.
- Learning Upgrade - XPRIZE winner.
- DLP uses Khan Academy, Edmentum Courseware, and Fast Forward.

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Print Resources



- Nine resources currently approved.
- Five resources currently being evaluated.
- Biggest needs: ESL and low-level ABE.
 - Challenging with text-heavy print resources.
- California Distance Learning Project.
 - Website currently down.
 - Outstanding instructionally – developed for DL.

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Use of Print Resources



- Develop structure/guide to support learners use.
 - What to work on.
 - What to submit.
 - Syllabus providing link to classroom activities.
- Ways to obtain student assignments.
 - US Mail – DLP provides addressed, stamped envelopes.
 - Text/email photos of work.
 - Dropbox.

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Timeline



- Currently finalizing rubric for approval.
 - Organization of content to support DL.
 - Instructional quality.
- Need to develop submission process.
- Webinar will be offered to explain requirements and submission process.
- Plan to launch in October.
